
# Be the SPARK That Ignites a Passion for STEM!

(Supporting Program Accessibility & Resources for K-8 Education)

CEF advances its mission by igniting a passion for science in young learners and preparing them for the opportunities of tomorrow. As STEM careers grow rapidly—half of which do not require a four-year degree—the need for early exposure to science and problem-solving has never been greater.

The Challenge is a team-based competition for students in grades 5–8 that connects classroom learning to real-world applications. Students explore pressing sustainability issues, strengthen their understanding of science, and build the creativity, collaboration, and communication skills needed to thrive in school and future careers.

As education standards and workforce needs evolve, so has the Challenge. Its impact is clear: 85% of participants report discovering new STEM career paths, 92% increase their interest in STEM, and 100% of Challenge winners pursue STEM after high school. These results reflect more than numbers. They represent the spark of curiosity that fuels tomorrow's STEM innovators.
